

CLAIR Gallery celebrates *The Inge Morath Truck Project* and the fabulous photographers involved in this artistic odyssey.

Inge Morath (1923 - 2002) is one of the most acclaimed photographers of the 20th century and was called 'the high priestess of photography' by the director John Huston. The *Inge Morath Truck Project* revisits one of Morath's most significant artistic ventures. As a member of the Magnum Photos agency, she travelled the length of the Danube both before and after the fall of the Soviet Union and captured stunning images of life along the river. The Truck Project brings together nine young women photographers who will retrace Morath's steps by traveling through 10 countries along the Danube in a truck that has been transformed into a mobile gallery.
